


2020 Beyond Columbia Survey Results: Columbia College (CC) and the Fu Foundation School of Engineering and Applied Science – Undergraduates (SEAS)

All numbers below represent the percentage of the Columbia College and the Fu Foundation School of Engineering and Applied Science – Undergraduates students who applied for graduation in October 2019, February 2020, or May 2020 and whose post-graduation outcome was collected in the 2020 Beyond Columbia Survey. The outcomes of 67.6% of all CC and SEAS degree-earners have been collected for this report as of December 31st, 2020.


Noteworthy Trends:

- 90.6% of graduates are employed or going to graduate school.
- Columbia University is the most popular destination for continued graduate studies.
- Finance, Consulting, and Engineering Web/Software are the top three job functions/roles graduates serve within employing organizations.



The Internet & Software, Investment Banking, and Management Consulting industries are the most popular for graduates who have accepted post-graduation employment.

- 62.6% of reported total compensation ranges are above \$70,000.
- 97.8% of respondents had one or more internships or research opportunities during their time as a Columbia University student. (n = 773)
